**Awareness Program for the members of Community Policing Committees –  
Community Policing Division**

A program was held to raise awareness among the members of Community Policing Committees in Jaffna and Kankesanthurai Police Divisions, on 17.03.2024 at 10.00 p.m. at the premises of US Hotel, Jaffna, under the leadership of Hon. Minister of Public Security, Mr. Tiran Alles, with the participation of the Secretary to the Ministry of Public Security, Mr. Viyani Gunathilaka, and the Inspector General of Police, Mr. Deshabandu Tennakoon.

Around 2000 Community policing members from 431 Grama Niladhari Divisions of Jaffna and Kankesanthurai Police Divisions have participated in this occasion. By addressing this gathering, the Minister of Public Security, Mr. Tiran Alles, and the Inspector General of Police stated that Operation Yukthiya will be further in progress to minimize crimes in the area, and investigations will be carried out by police stations based on complaints and information in connection with crimes received through the "107" Emergency Call Centre, which is functioning 24-hours focusing on the Tamil community living in the North Eastern province.

A dance troupe of the "Swasthi Fine" Dancing Academy added colour to this occasion, and the Minister of Public Security, Mr. Tiran Alles, Ministry of Public Security, Mr. Viyani Gunathilaka, and the Inspector General of Police were presented with mementos by high-ranking police officers, including Mr. Mahinda Gunarathne, Senior Deputy Inspector General Police in charge of the Northern Province, to mark the occasion.

Religious observances relevant to all religions were conducted on behalf of the participants and a number of high ranking officers of Sri Lanka Police have also participated in this event.
