To All OICC -- Divisions/Districts/Stations,

AMENDMENT TO PG NO.77 OF 7TH NOVEMBER 1973.

The following amendments are made to the P.G. II No.77 of 7th November 1973 which would be published in the PG II in due course:

Amendment to Para 1 @ Election of office bearers:

HQ/OIC of each Police Station/Unit should summon a meeting of all officers in respective Stations/Units and elect representatives from each rank to the Divisional Welfare Council Members to be elected will be on the following ratio:

- (I) CI/IPP/SII/WIPP/WSII one to be elected for 05 Officers and above and 02 to be elected if the number is more than 15.
- (II) SMM/PSS/PCC/WPSS/WPCC one Officer to be elected for an Unit of 20.

The above Officers elected will comprise the Divisional Welfare Council.

- (III) 02 Mechanic PSS/PCC, 02 WTO PSS/PCC and 02 Band PSS/PCC should be elected by the transport Division, Communications Division and Field Force Headquarters respectively to be represented at the Central Welfare Council.

Director Transport, Director Communications and Director Music should take action to elect such officers and inform their names to Director Welfare. These Officers will be members of the Executive Committee of the Central Welfare Council.

No Officer elected to the Divisional or Central Welfare Council shall hold office for more than two consecutive years.

Para - 1 © to be deleted.

Para - 2 to be deleted

Para - 3 to read as follows:

The Divisional Welfare Councils and Central Welfare Council will also function as Advisory Committees in terms of Public Administration Circular No.08 of 15th August 1970

Para - 5 to read as follows:

The Secretary of each Divisional Welfare Council shall keep accurate minutes of every meeting and transmit a copy of the minutes to the Chairman Central Welfare Council. If there are any matters to be considered by the Central Welfare Council, such matters will be sent to the Secretary of the Central Welfare Council.

Para - 6 (b) to read as follows:

Transmit to the Deputy Inspector general of Police (Welfare) without delay the names of office bearers and representatives elected to the Police Central Welfare Council.

Para - 11 to read as follows :

Copies of Minutes of all Executive Committee meetings as well as Divisional Welfare Council meetings shall be transmitted without delay to the Deputy Inspector General of Police (Welfare) and to the Secretary of the Central Welfare Council for their information.

Para - 13 (a) to be Deleted.

Para - 13 (b) to be amended as follows:

Two Senior Gazetted Officers shall be elected for the Central Welfare Council at the Annual General Meeting of the Senior Police Officers Mess. The Officers so elected shall not hold office for more than two terms.

Para - 14 To read as follows:

At the first meeting of the Police Central Welfare Council, following office bearers shall be elected.

Secretary; and
Assistant Secretary.

The Deputy Inspector General of Police (Welfare) shall preside at this meeting.

Amendment to Para - 15

In addition to the office bearers elected under Section 14, 02 CII/IPP/SII, 01 WIP/WSI/ 02 PSS, 02 WPSS, 02 PCC, 02 WPC & 01 PSD/PCD will also be elected by the respective ranks as Committee Members. A Sergeant Major elected to CWC, 02 Mechanic PSS/PCC, 02 WTO PSS/PCC and a Band PS/PC in the Central Welfare Council will also be considered as Committee Members.

Para - 17

To read as follows:

The Police Central Welfare Council shall meet at least once in three months or at the request of the Deputy Inspector General of Police (Welfare) or at least one-third the membership. The quorum for a meeting of the Central Welfare Council shall be one-third the membership.
