Foundation Stone Laid for New Administrative Building of Mirigama Police Station

The Mirigama Police Station, which has been functioning in an outdated building, marked a significant milestone with the laying of the foundation stone for its new administrative complex. The ceremony was held on the morning of 25 February 2026 at the police station premises.

The event was graced by the Hon. Minister of Public Security and Parliamentary Affairs, Ananda Wijepala, and attended by the Inspector General of Police, Attorney-at-Law Mr. Priyantha Weerasooriya.

The proposed building is designed to accommodate all essential divisions of a fully functional police station, ensuring improved efficiency and enhanced public service delivery. The estimated cost of the project is approximately LKR 80 million.

Among the distinguished attendees were Senior Deputy Inspector General (DIG) in charge of the Western Province, Sajeewa Medawatte; DIG in charge of the Northern Division of the Western Province, Kalinga Jayasinghe; DIG in charge of the Narathana Division, Priyankara de Silva; and Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) in charge of the Gampaha Division, Sanath Amarasinghe.

Religious leaders, local public representatives, senior police officers, and residents of the area also participated in the occasion.
